



Declaration of Compliance to California Proposition 65

According to California EPA's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA): The California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 (Proposition 65) requires the State to publish a list of chemicals known to cause cancer or birth defects or other reproductive harm. The current list contains over 900 chemicals which include naturally occurring substances and chemicals used in manufacturing and processing of products.

Under Proposition 65, it is the duty of the manufacturer to advise its customers of potential chemicals from the 900+ listed that might have trace amounts known by the state of California to do harm. Because of these requirements, SSP will now include warnings, where applicable, on the outermost packaging of all products being shipped into the state of California. We will also include the warning on the packing list of all products being shipped into the state of California.

The warning does not mean our products will cause cancer or reproductive harm, nor that it is in violation of any safety standards or regulations. It is a public "Right to Know" notice that the product may contain or have traces of said chemicals.
